Executive Summary

The Women On The Tools report was created to uncover what it means to be a tradeswoman in 2022.

Through working with industry supporters and brand sponsors we were able to engage across the breadth of the UK construction industry to consider the views of tradeswomen, tradesmen and the general public to compile a comprehensive report.

The report has been downloaded over 600 times since it launched for International Women's Day on 8th March 2022, with strong social media and digital engagement received across the industry.

The report acts as a pivotal step in understanding the challenges faced, and the changes that are needed ahead.
